LEADING BY EXAMPLE

TO ARM

In Genesis, we learn that God walked in the cool of the evening with Adam. In Exodus, we learn God fed and provided for all the needs of the Israelites in the wilderness. In Isaiah, we learn God put on His armor and intervened to help the oppressed. In John, we learn the love God has for His people.

Walking with someone may seem like a simple thing; but setting aside the things that are important to share a moment with someone is anything but simple. The American Psychological Associates states that walking with someone plays a role in the development of interpersonal relationships (<https://psycnet.apa.org/record/2020-81815-001>). God chose to specifically tell us that He walked with Adam in the cool of the evening. What He *implies* is that He set aside many important things to develop a relationship with Adam.

Assuming you are new to the planet, I'll tell you feeding someone is the very basic of basic care. We must eat to survive. In the wilderness, the Israelites faced nothing. Well, nothing but a bunch of "wilderness". Instead of growing some plants or sending a cow, the Lord decided to make it rain food (Exodus 16:4). The whole 40 years of wilderness is an important showing of the Lord's provision. The Lord specifically states that He will provide all that we need.

What prompts you to action? What makes your blood boil with anger? What causes such a dangerous reaction?

The Gospel of John tells a beautiful story of love. God in all His love (He who *is* love) sent His most precious Son to die specifically so we could access Him. I love y'all, but I won't allow Lianna to die for anyone.

So the Lord our God has a strategy. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places (Ephesians 6:12). For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh (2 Corinthians 10:3).

To effectively occupy the land, God told the Israelites to go into the land and kill every living thing (Deuteronomy 20:16-17).

This all happened in the natural realm. Not with natural power - the Lord already gave it to them - but they did have to actually go take some land that belonged to someone else.

We are told the same. We are given a command by the Lord of Hosts to ensure we occupy this land. It looks a little different now, but the command "to occupy" is still the same.

Today we are to pull down strongholds, cast down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God...(2 Corinthians 10:4-5). This doesn't always include physical spaces and places.

I think most of us can agree that strongholds these days go way deeper than a line drawn in the physical sand. Arguments against God are not always transgender or abortion related. Everything high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God is often the flesh itself. The traumas, the ideas, the walls and borders we put around our hearts and minds that do not allow the knowledge of God to penetrate.

These things are often harder to pull down and cast down than any physical enemy we may face. In the digital age, we can simply shut off our phone, leave a situation, or speak the name of Jesus. But have you ever tried to shut off your mind? Leave your body in the next room? Speak the name of Jesus against your heart?

I am not totally convinced that we can't do these things.

Jesus said, "...if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move..." (Matt 17:20 NKJV).

Our command to occupy this land - however intangible the land may be - can only be accomplished through faith. We know we all have a measure of faith, but do we have faith enough to speak the name of Jesus against our own hearts?

Commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass, Psalm 37:5.

Two steps:

1. Commit your way to the Lord
2. Trust also in Him

And HE shall bring it to pass.
